



## BRSC Covid Roadmap For Restarting Sailing And Opening

All of the following steps are **subject to change with dates and the Government are making their decisions on the following four tests:**

- The vaccine programme continues successfully
- Evidence shows vaccines are sufficiently effective in reducing hospitalisations and deaths in those vaccinated
- Infection rates don't risk a surge in hospitalisations that would put a strain on the NHS
- Their assessment of the risks is not fundamentally changed by new Variants of Covid

### **Roadmap**

#### **Step 1 - From now:**

- Members can access equipment to rig and sail
- Members can carry out work on club boats, tidy boat park and cut grass
- You can go out for exercise on the water with 1 other person
- No organised activities
- No showers or toilets available
- No work carried out on Members boats, unless essential for Health and Safety reasons
- No social gatherings
- No safety boat cover
- No travelling out of your area
- Club only to be accessed for / visited for exercise (water activities) and work (volunteering) as outlined above

#### **Step 1 - From 29<sup>th</sup> March**

- Outside shower accessible
- Racing allowed – **IF** safety boat cover is pre-organised and can socially distance whilst launching / recovering / on the water
- Safety boat crew (and sailors) must have read the following document

- Personal recreational sailing permitted
- You can travel out of your area
- Changing rooms remain closed
- Toilets can open **but** on the proviso that that a designated volunteer cleans and locks them at specified times on Saturdays and Sundays. They will be locked at all other times and not accessible during the week. If a volunteer isn't arranged for these days and times, they cannot open. This is to keep in line with strict Covid measures
- No gatherings above 6 people

#### **Step 2 - From 12<sup>th</sup> April**

- Club can open for outside customers only. Club will open on Sundays, times TBA
- Table service only
- Possibly toilet only accessible from back door
- Take-aways are possible outside when the club is open / closed – rule of 6 applies
- Toilets open at designated times on Saturdays (as above - reliant on designated volunteer to clean them)
- Changing rooms can open when the club is open
- Outside shower available on Saturday when the Club is closed

#### **Step 3 - From 17<sup>th</sup> May**

- Club can open for inside customers, as well as outside – times TBA, but will be a reduced opening
- Table service still applies
- Rule of 6 applies – no mixing of bubbles / households
- Volunteers may still be needed to clean the toilets, depending on our opening days
